Shrimping ECO Educational Boat Tour

Our Shrimping ECO Tours are classrooms on the water providing a fun experience combined with ecological education and are much more fun than school!

We will take your group along the intra-coastal waterway, salt marshes and wilderness beaches. We often see dolphin and in warmer months there are often sea turtles, manatees, egrets, herons, roseate spoonbills, and osprey. We have conducted our Shrimping ECO tours for thousands of students for over 20 years.

Shrimp nets are placed in the water and pulled along the bottom with the boat for about 10 minutes. During the tour our crew will discuss different topics on ecology and environmental issues that impact the coastal estuary. Then after a brief instruction, the group becomes participants in the experience by pulling the trawl net into the boat. A bounty of species is generally pulled up with the net and placed into containers. Our staff will give a complete presentation of the species caught, and then an opportunity is given to the group to touch and handle the catch before it is returned to the water.

Our comfortable boats are US Coast Guard certified for 49 passengers each, are equipped with a sun cover and bathroom. All our Captains are Master Mariners with years of experience in the local history and ecology of the pristine Georgia Coastline. Let's go!
